Each Module has six classes, and meets for 3 hours per class.

MODULE 1: Handbuilding and Sculpting | Saturdays - September 11 & 18, October 2 & 16, November 6 & 20, 2021

Create sculptures and pottery using clay. Students will learn the basic skills of handbuilding, working with clay and glazes.

MODULE 2: Pottery on the Wheel | Saturdays - December 4 & 11, 2021, January 15 & 29, February 5 & 19, 2022

Make plates and bowls on the potter's wheel. Participants will also learn how to use and apply ceramic glazes for color and design.

MODULE 3: Raku | Saturdays - March 5 & 12, April 2 & 16, May 7 & 14, 2022

Objects made in class will be fired in a variety of techniques based upon the ancient Japanese art of raku.
