## Supply List:

## If you are Drawing

Grey toned paper, 16x20" minimum, 2-3 sheets
Black, white, sanguine, sepia, \& blue charcoal and pastel (pencils or sticks)
chamois or rags
variety of erasers
If you are Painting:
Panels: 2-3 panels, $12 \times 16-16 \times 20$ ", toned with a middle grey (the larger panel can be used for multiple short studies).
I recommend Centurion Oil Primed linen panels
Oil paint: Ivory Black, Titanium White, Transparent Brown Oxide, Burnt Sienna or
Transparent Red Oxide, Yellow Ochre, Raw Sienna, Ultramarine Blue

## Odorless mineral spirits

Medium: Linseed oil, walnut alkyd or Liquin
Solvent: Good quality OMS such as Turpenoid (original, not natural) or Gamsol
Brushes: Bristle filberts are great all purpose brushes - I like Silver Brush Grand Prix
but many brands are good. Some soft hair or synthetic fiber brushes.
Flats, angled shaders, combers, and fan brushes are useful brush types.

## Paper towels, rags

Palette knives for mixing paint (steel, not plastic)
Palette, at least $12 \times 16$ ", grey or white surface color
