Please bring the watercolor materials you normally use for watercolor painting.

If you are new to watercolor you may need the following:

- 1. A number 8 round watercolor brush
- 2. A 1/2 inch !at watercolor brush (an inch would be best)
- 3. A palette to put your paints on
- 4. Watercolor tube paints: Or purchase a small watercolor kit
  - a. ultramarine
  - b. cadmium vellow
  - c. cadmium red
  - d. alizarin crimson
  - e. sap green
  - f. burnt seinna
  - g. cerulean blue
- 5. Small spray bottle and paper towels
- 6. A small sheet of cardboard or plexi to support your watercolor paper.
- 7. Watercolor paper. I will be using a quarter sheet of cold press paper for the demonstration. Use the size you enjoy the most.
- 8. A small container for water.
- 9. A pencil
- 10. Tape to attach your paper to your cardboard or plexi. You can use blue tape.

I will supply the tissue paper for the collage.
