**Recommended Gouache Paints:** (DO NOT use 'Acrylic Gouache' for this workshop!) I prefer Winsor & Newton Designer Gouache but there are many brands available. The ShinHan Gouache Set of 12 is a professional paint at a budget-friendly price available on Amazon. Utrecht Gouache at DickBlick.com is also a great professional paint option that I use often.
