Recommended Supply List for Oil painters.

Note: The following list is only a recommendation. If you already have an inventory of oil paints, use them first. Listed is a basic palette of colors suitable for various subjects; you can use the colors you like.

*Attention oil painters: Please use Gamsol only when using traditional oil paints! When I paint in oil, I prefer <u>Water-Mixable Oil</u> along with <u>Water-Mixable Painting Medium</u> as a solvent-free option allowing super easy soap and water clean up.
□ Canvas: Acrylic-primed in a variety of sizes. 8x10 - 16x20. If you are new to painting I recommend working small (6x8 - 8x10) so that you can finish many quickly. The more paintings you paint, the quicker you will learn!
☐ Palette: 12 x 16 Grey Matters or 12 x 16 paper palette.
□ Palette Storage: (optional) <u>Masterson 12x16 Sta-Wet Palette</u> to store and transport wet oil paint so that you can preserve your color mixtures between classes.
☐ Professional Oil Paint: Cobra Water-Mixable Oil or Traditional: Gamblin, Utrecht,
Winsor Newton, or Rembrandt.
