

Supply List:

Preferred is [Winsor & Newton Designer Gouache](#) but there are many brands available. Just make

sure that you always buy Professional Artist-Quality Paints. Note: Acryla-gouache is not

recommended for this workshop.

Colors: Suggested Palette of 12 colors. You are free to use your favorite colors too!

Permanent White (Big Tube - 37 ml 1.25 fl oz)

Primary Yellow , or Spectrum Yellow

Perm. Yellow Deep

Yellow Ocher

Flame Red, Primary Red, or Windsor Red

Permanent Alizarin Crimson

Burnt Sienna

Ultramarine Blue

Windsor Blue

Windsor Violet

Brilliant Green

Perm. Sap Green - or - Olive Green

Palette: Butcher Tray 7.5 x 11 inches

Surfaces: There are plenty of surface options for gouache painting.

Fluid 100 Cold Press Watercolor Block 300 lb. sizes 5x7 up to 9x12.

Cottonwood Arts Cold Press Block 5x7 up to 8x10

Or, any cold press watercolor paper or pad will be suitable.

Brushes: I like Princeton and Robert Simmons brushes but any brand synthetic brush will work.
